Before beginning, complete setup of your Amazon device(s) in the Amazon Alexa app:

- 1. Download the LG SmartThinQ app
- 2. Register and sign-in to your SmartThinQ account
- 3. Add your LG Air Conditioner to your Devices
- 4. Navigate to the Alexa app and enable the SmartThinQ Skill
- 5. Discover LG Air Conditioner in Alexa App to complete setup



Before beginning, complete setup of your Google Home device(s) in the Google Assistant app:

- 1. Download the LG SmartThinQ app
- 2. Register and sign-in to your SmartThinQ account
- 3. Add your LG Air Conditioner to your Devices
- 4. Navigate to the Google Home app
- 5. Select "Add Device" and Link LG SmartThinQ account to complete setup

Examples of Voice Commands

Turn On/Off

Alexa, turn on/off air conditioner.

Check Current Room Temperature

Alexa, what is the temperature of the air conditioner?

Check Set Temperature

Alexa, what is the air conditioner set to?

Set or Modify Temperature

Alexa, set air conditioner to 65 degrees.

Alexa, increase/decrease air conditioner by two degrees.

Check or Change Heat/Cool Mode

Alexa, what mode is the air conditioner in?

Alexa, change air conditioner to cooling/heating.

Turn On/Off

Ok Google, turn on/off air conditioner.

Check Temperature

Ok Google, what is the temperature of the air conditioner?

Set or Modify Temperature

Ok Google, set air conditioner to 65 degrees.

Ok Google, increase/decrease air conditioner by two degrees.

Check or Change Heat/Cool Mode

Ok Google, what mode is the air conditioner in?

Ok Google, change air conditioner to cooling/heating.
